

	<p>Ten-Year Facilities Planning – Article Series</p> <p>Article 4 – What We Are Hearing, Part 2 Teacher, Staff, and Student Survey Responses</p>
<p>Teacher Comment: “We just need more space. We all work very hard for our wonderful students ... having the space to support them is immensely needed.”</p>	<p>Student Comment: “These needs are very important and I am passionate about the future of this school. ... I care about this school and the future of it. I will continue to even after I leave ...”</p>

Hinsdale County School District surveyed teachers, staff, and middle/high school students as part of the assessment of the current facilities. Responses were received from 20 teachers and staff, 60% having been at the school for 5 or more years. Fifty students responded, 72% being in high school.

Highlights of the teacher and staff responses:

- Are there sufficient classrooms for core subjects (language arts, math, science, social studies/history)? 80% said no.
- Are there sufficient classrooms for non-core subjects (music, art, physical education, technology, and other)? 100% said no.
- What support spaces are needed? 95% rated small group instructional spaces as high.
- What are the highest large group assembly space needs? 100% rated gymnasium as high.
- Are conference areas adequate for confidentiality and privacy? 95% said no.
- Does the current technology infrastructure meet student needs? 60% said no.
- Does the physical education facility meet student needs? 95% said inadequate.
- Are there safety concerns related to the facility? 78% said yes.

Highlights of the student responses:

- For core subjects, do our classrooms meet our needs? 34% said no.
- For non-core subjects, do our classrooms meet our needs? 65% said no.
- What support spaces need to be added? Storage, restrooms, and small group instruction spaces were rated highest.
- What large assembly space needs are highest? 80% rated gymnasium as high.
- How adequate are the physical education facilities? 61% said inadequate.
